Debra bought a chair for 125 dollars, a table for 90 dollars and a computer for 875 dollars. How much money did Debra spend altogether?

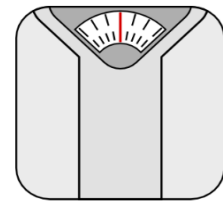


### Question 6

Yesterday Peter started doing his homework at 8.00 pm. He worked for 30 minutes. At what time did he finish?

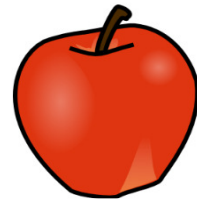


### Question 10
